



Can you identify the features?

Materials

- *Two sets of laminated headings – Imaginative, Persuasive and Informative*
- *Two boxes with laminated text features*

How to play

- *Players are in two groups*
- *There will be three headings – Imaginative, Persuasive & Informative*
- *Each group will be given a box of text features and they must place the features under the correct heading.*
- *When one team is finished and they believe they have all the correct features the teacher will make both teams stop and check. If they have some wrong the teacher will say “No Deal” both teams continue placing the features under the headings and the game continues until one team has all the correct answers.*
- *If the players are struggling to figure out which feature is under the incorrect heading the teacher can give clues.*
