

Materials

- Fish
- Fishing Rods
- Fish ponds x 3

How to play

- Each player takes turns using the fishing rod to pick up a fish.
- Once a player has picked up a fish they must quickly identify to which text type the characteristic belongs.
- Once they have identified the text type correctly they must place the fish in the pond with the correct label.

 Extension – an extension on this activity is for players to give examples from previously studied texts or other well-known texts they know.
